Authorizing the County Executive to sign Public Works Assistance Fund Loan Agreement No. 06-2019 with the City of Bothell for its Camden Crest Sewer Lift Station #4 Replacement Project.

Background

Council passed Ordinance 16-055, recreating SCC Chapter 4.117, titled the Snohomish County Public Works Assistance Fund, for the purposes of providing loans to the County and other local governments to assist in funding public works projects located wholly or partially within the county. In September of 2016, Council passed Motion 16-377, establishing that the resources of the Snohomish County Public Works Assistance Fund, the prioritization and competitive application processes and the terms, conditions, and interest rates are sufficient to support one or more loans to local governments.

The City of Bothell submitted an application for the Camden Crest Sewer Lift Station #4 Replacement project in the amount of \$75,000. The Countywide Scoring Committee reviewed and scored the application, finding the project met the program's eligibility criteria and agreed with the project moving forward. The City of Bothell has completed project design and planned to begin construction in March of 2021, with substantial completion scheduled for June of 2021.

This motion authorizes the County Executive to sign Public Works Assistance Fund Loan Agreement 06-2019 with the City of Bothell in the amount of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000.00).
