### **PURPOSE:**

Approve Conservation Futures Board funding recommendation for allocation of Conservation Futures Property Tax Funds

# **BACKGROUND:**

November 21, 1988 – The Snohomish County Council established the Snohomish County Conservation Futures Property Tax Fund as per Snohomish County Code Chapter 4.14.

September 20, 1989 – The Snohomish County Council, by amended Ordinance, established a Conservation Futures Program Advisory Board as per Snohomish County Code Chapter 4.14; duties include the review and recommendation of applications for projects to be funded with Conservation Futures Property Tax Funds.

April 20, 2022 – The Board directed staff to proceed with a grant round for consideration of funding recommendations. The amount of funds available from the estimated Conservation Futures Property Tax through end of year 2022, including the 2021 bond totaled approximately \$16,707,363.84. The board may choose to recommend allocation of some or all that amount.

June 29, 2022 – The Board, at its zoom meeting heard the grant presentations from the 5 project sponsors and 4 Letters of Intent to inform the board of future acquisition opportunities. The board deliberated and voted at the meeting. After careful deliberation the Board recommended fully funding each of the five (5) projects as follows:
