**Subject:** LEAD Program – Contract with Purpose. Dignity. Action

Approve amendment #1 to the contract with Purpose. Dignity. Action. (PDA). PDA performs the administrative functions of the County's LEAD

program. Amendment #1 would:

 Extends the term of the agreement to June 30, 2025 (four oneyear extensions are allowed under the contract, approval of this motion would leave three potential future extensions)

Increases the do not exceed amount by \$565,000

- Provides a \$50,000 lump sum payment for flex funds to support clients actively engaged in LEAD and Recovery Navigator Program (RNP) programs. Funds can be used for housing, shelter, identification, food, clothing, and other basic needs.

**<u>Authority Granted:</u>** Authorize the Executive to execute the amendment.

<u>Background:</u> In June 2020, the Council passed <u>Motion 20-212</u> approving a \$1.69 million grant award from the Washington State Health Care Authority (HCA) to implement a Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion (LEAD) program<sup>1</sup> from June 9, 2020 through June 30, 2021. The county entered into an agreement with the PDA on August 16, 2021 to reimburse for LEAD Project Management Expenses; the original agreement was approved by <u>Motion 21-266</u>. With expiration of the original agreement, a new one was approved through <u>Motion 23-555</u>
