### **Consideration:**

Appointing Commissioner to represent the Business Sector on the Citizens' Commission on Salaries of Elected Officials.

### **Background**

Snohomish County Ordinance 07-053, passed in June of 2007, established the Snohomish County Citizen's Commission on Salaries of Elected Officials. Local code charges the Auditor with randomly selecting six Snohomish County citizens – one from each Council District and one at-large – from the county voter registration rolls to serve on the Commission on Salaries. The County Executive is responsible for nominating four individuals – one from each of the following sectors; business, personnel management, legal profession, and organized labor.

For 2022, Carolyn Brennan has expressed interest in being appointed to represent the Business Sector. Ms. Brennan currently is Chancellor of Connected Learning and Research at UW Bothell, and has extensive work and volunteer experience in the management of operations and staff.

To appoint Carolyn Brennan, as required by SCC 2.105.040(3) to a two-year term on the Snohomish County Citizen's Commission on Salaries of Elected Officials.
