I am pleased to recommend the reappointment of Patricia O'Maley-Lanphear to serve her fourth three-year term on the North Sound Behavioral Health Administration Organization Advisory Board (NSBHASO).

The State Legislature enacted SSB 5400 in 1989, which allows interested counties to form a regional support network for certain mental health services. Five counties of Northwestern Washington coinciding with DSHS Region 3 (Island, San Juan, Skagit, Snohomish, and Whatcom) comprise the North Sound Regional Support Network, which is now known as North Sound Behavioral Health Administrative Services Organization or NSBHASO. The NSBHASO Advisory Board advocates for the interests of mentally ill persons and their families and substance use disorder persons, and provides recommendations to the NSBHASO Board of Directors, which is made up of elected officials from the five counties. The Advisory Board is comprised of 26 members; 9 from Snohomish County. Board members serve three-year terms and are appointed by Council on recommendation of the Executive.

Patricia O'Maley-Lanphear, residing in Council District 1, is seeking reappointment to her fourth three-year term on the North Sound Behavioral Health Administration Organization Advisory Board. Ms. O'Maley-Lanphear has been a community health advocate professionally for over twenty years. Her reappointment will continue to add diversity to the County's representation on the NSBHASO Advisory Board.

Pursuant to SCC 2.03.030, I hereby urge Council confirmation of Patricia O'Maley-Lanphear to be reappointed to the North Sound Behavioral Health Administration Organization Advisory Board to serve a fourth three-year term ending June 30, 2028.
