RELATED TO THE 2021 BUDGET; MAKING A
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN PARKS
CONSTRUCTION FUND 309 TO PROVIDE EXPENDITURE
AUTHORITY FOR PARKS IMPROVEMENTS

Section 1. The County Council makes the following findings of fact: a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$300,000, is necessary to provide expenditure authority in the Parks Construction Fund 309, for budget year 2021, to fund grant-funded improvements to the County's Meadowdale Park & Estuary.
