Section 1. The Council adopts and incorporates the foregoing

Section 2. The County Council finds that the county road rightof-way described in Exhibit A and depicted in Exhibit B, both
attached and incorporated by reference into the Ordinance is
useless for county road durposes and the public will be benefitted
by their vacation.
Section 3. The county road right-of-way described and depicted
in the attached exhibits are vacated upon satisfaction of the terms

Section 4. Under Chapter 13.100 SCC, the vacation of the
