BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

The contemplated work to be performed under this contract includes, but is not limited to, Vactor Waste Storage Facility Work: Contractor shall construct a nominal 60 foot by 75 foot tensioned fabric structure for temporary storage of vactor waste adjacent to a similar existing structure at the Project Site. The work includes the following: removal of existing asphalt paving, site grading and fill for the new facility floor slab, reinforced concrete floor slab, precast concrete block walls placed on the new floor slab, supply and erection of the tensioned fabric structure on the precast concrete block foundation walls, asphalt pavement and pavement patching, replace the fabric cover on the adjacent existing structure. All work is in accordance with the requirements set forth in the specifications, drawings and contract documents.
