CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF STEPHEN ZIRSCHKY  
TO THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY ETHICS COMMISSION

WHEREAS, SCC 2.50.080 establishes the creation of the Snohomish County Ethics Commission, consisting of five members nominated by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council; and

WHEREAS, any person with knowledge of a Snohomish County Ethics Code violation by a county employee, or any person dealing with Snohomish County government, may file a complaint with the Snohomish County Ethics Commission; and

WHEREAS, it is the Commission's duty to examine questionable behavior, as defined by the Snohomish County Ethics Code, and to resolve complaints; and

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County's Ethics Commission exists as a non-biased resource for the community and can provide information and solutions; and

WHEREAS, Stephen Zirschky has served as a member of the Snohomish County Ethics Commission since 2024 and desires reappointment to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, Stephen Zirschky has a long history of serving the public through Washington State boards and committees and is an experienced leader and attorney;


NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the Snohomish County Council confirms the appointment to Stephen Zirschky to the Snohomish County Ethics Commission Position 4 to serve a second and final term that expires June 30, 2029.
