**Background:** Snohomish County retains the services of an employee benefits consultant to provide actuarial services for its self-insured health plan, as well as insurance brokerage and other services necessary for the management of its employee benefits program. The original agreement, a result of RFP 015-20BC is being amended to include additional services related to the RxDC Submission required by Section 204 (of Title II, Division BB) of the Consolidated Appropriation Act, 2021, which requires insurance companies and employer-based health plans submit information about prescription drug and health care spending.
