Background:

Council and Executive. Terms on the commission are four years. (More details about the Planning Commission are on page 3). All planning commission positions are all currently occupied.

The Board: The Planning Commission is an 11-member advisory body to the County

The Nominee: Merle Ash has recently completed a second full term on the Planning Commission and continues to serve under SCC 2.03.030(2) during the processing of this motion to reappoint him. He is a resident of Council District 1, owns a land use consultancy, and brings hands-on experience to the commission.

Councilmember Nate Nehring is nominating Merle Ash to a third full term as a District 1 representative. Merle Ash is well-qualified to continue serving. His experience brings a practical perspective and maintains balance on the Planning Commission. After completing this third full term, Merle Ash would need to have a period of two years' absence from the commission before being eligible to serve again (SCC 2.03.050).

Request: Move Motion 24-285 to General Legislative Session on July 24 to set date and time for a public hearing. Suggested date and time: Wednesday August 14, 2024, at 9:00 a.m.

Exhibit B. Composition and Requirements of the Planning Commission

The Snohomish County Planning Commission is an advisory body to the County Council and County Executive. The commission holds public hearings and provides recommendations on proposed changes to the county's comprehensive plan and development regulations. The commission has positions for eleven members, two from each council district and one at-large member nominated by the executive, which serve four-year terms and may not serve more than two complete consecutive terms.

Snohomish County Code (2.03.060 and 2.08.080) provides that the council appoints planning commission members. Requirements are that commissioners:

- 1. Not be county employees;
- 2. Have sufficient time to attend all scheduled meetings, and
- Not serve on more than two boards or commissions at the same time (ad hoc or advisory committees do not count against the limit).

County code also provides that nominees should possess attributes including a background in one or more of the following:

- Architecture
- Law
- Farming
- Recreation
- Finance
- Real estate
- Environment
- Construction
- Fisheries
- Engineering
- Appraisal
- Land use planning
- Education
- Related backgrounds, or job knowledge or interests

Nominees should also have knowledge of land use theories and growth management legislation, minimal potential for conflict of interest, a demonstrated interest in the welfare of Snohomish County, and should add balance to countywide representation on the commission.
