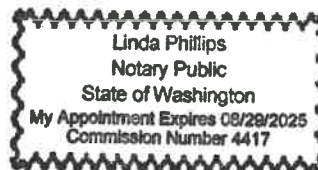

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Snohomish County Council will hold a public hearing to consider Proposed Ordinance 21-038 on Wednesday, August 25, 2021, at the hour of 10:30 a.m. at 3000 Rockefeller Avenue, 8th Floor, Jackson Board Room, Everett, WA, in conjunction with a remote meeting via the following Zoom link:

A summary of the proposed ordinances is as follows:

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 21-046
RELATING TO CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS -- APPRENTICE REQUIREMENTS; AMENDING CHAPTER 3.05 SCC

Sections 1 – 3.05.025 Use of apprentices required for public works. Amends Snohomish County Code Section 3.05.025 to relocate language from Section 3.05.040, waiving apprenticeship requirements when they conflict with federal funding conditions. Presently, when apprenticeship requirements conflict with federal funding conditions, the Purchasing Division does not include the apprenticeship specification in the bid documents. The relocation of this language more accurately represents the County's actual process.

Sections 2 – 3.05.030 Administration. Amends Snohomish County Code Section 3.05.030, subsection (2) to add language to further clarify that the apprentice utilization plan required prior to contract execution must reflect the contractor's plan to meet the 15% labor hour goal.

Sections 3 – 3.05.040 Exceptions and Waivers. Amends Snohomish County Code Section 3.05.040, subsections (1) and (2) to remove and relocate language to Section 3.05.025.

Sections 4 – 3.05.050 Monitoring. Amends Snohomish County Code Section 3.05.050 to remove a word that was misplaced during the previous amendment to this section.

At the hearing, Council may consider alternatives/amendments to the proposed ordinance.

State Environmental Policy Act. Pursuant to Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 197.11.800(19), this proposal is categorically exempt from State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) requirements.
