Amends Snohomish County Code Section 3.05.025 to relocate language from Section 3.05.040, waiving apprenticeship requirements when they conflict with federal funding conditions, the Purchasing Division does not include the apprenticeship specification in the blid documents. The relocation of this language more accurately represents the County's actual process.
