Subject: Annual Future of Flight Certification Letter

Scope: Motion 25-052 would authorize the County Executive and County Council Chair to sign the annual compliance certification letter for 2024 addressed to the Snohomish County Public Facilities District.

The 2024 Certification Compliance Letter discusses money already spent in 2024. There is no impact to the 2025 or future year budgets.

Authority Granted: Authorization for the Council Chair and County Executive to sign the letter.

Background: Snohomish County and the Snohomish County Public Facilities District (PFD) entered an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) for the development of a regional center at Paine Field on December 17, 2003. This center is now the Future of Flight Aviation Center. Subsequent ILA addendums in 2009 and 2020 made revisions for how revenue collected for the PFD would be allocated. Addendum 1 (2009) requires the County to provide annual written certification of compliance with the terms and conditions of the ILA, as amended. This compliance letter also needs to show the amount and sources of the 33% required matching funds required by RCW 82.14.390(4) and (5).

The 2024 compliance certification letter states that all terms of the ILA, including amendments are being complied. It also provides the amount (\$593,696) of local matching support in 2024, which is 56.7% of the total amount spent (\$1,047,050) on debt payments and renovation. The ILA requires both the County Executive and Chair of the County Council to sign the letter.
