Background: The US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires Snohomish County adopt the Snohomish County Urban County Consortium's annual action plan (Plan) to receive federal grant funds under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships, and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) programs. The grant funds are used for affordable housing, facilities providing community services, infrastructure projects, homeless programs, and economic development activities. The funds must primarily benefit low-income individuals. Snohomish County is the lead agency for the Consortium.

On May 1, 2019, the Council passed Motion 19-093 approving the Snohomish County Urban County Consortium 2019 Annual Action Plan for HUD housing and community development programs. This plan has been amended multiple times since adoption, significantly \$4,925,992 of Coronavirus Aid was allocated to the County by HUD on March 27, 2020. Under this allotment of Coronavirus funding, \$619,176 was proposed for public facilities and infrastructure projects. Through a Notice of Funding Opportunity one eligible project applied for these funds, the Policy Advisory Board (PAB) met and made a recommendation to fund the project which is now before Council.
