NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on November 29, 2023, the Snohomish County Council approved Ordinance No. 23-127.

ORDINANCE NO. 23-127

ESTABLISHING THE 2024 MONTHLY VEHICLE ALLOWANCE OF  
ELECTED OFFICIALS PURSUANT TO SCC 3.36.035(2)

**Summary:** Snohomish County Code 3.36.035 requires the Director of the Department of Facilities and Fleet to annually review average monthly Equipment Rental and Revolving (ER&R) cost for replacement, maintenance, insurance and fuel expenses of a standard size county pool vehicle and report that average monthly cost to the Council. The Director of Facilities and Fleet has determined that the average monthly ER&R cost for 2024 is \$616.06. The Council may set the elected official reimbursement for 2024 at not more than 99 percent of the average monthly ER&R cost, or \$609.90.

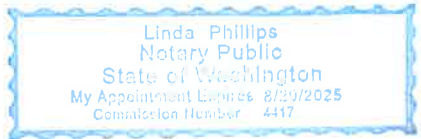
