The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 21-423 which would approve Amendment No. 1 to the 2021 Contract for Legal Services with Keating, Bucklin & McCormack.

<u>Background</u>

The original agreement for legal services with Harrigan Leyh Farmer & Thomsen was executed on April 7, 2020 for a not-to-exceed amount of \$50,000. The outside counsel is representing Snohomish County in a lawsuit related to alleged excessive use of force.

Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 21-423 approves Amendment No. which increases the not-to-exceed amount of the agreement. All other terms and conditions are the same.

Duration: Unknown

Fiscal Implications: Not to exceed \$150,000
