Sno-Isle Libraries is governed by a seven-member Board of Trustees who set library policies, review and approve the annual budget, determine the general direction of the Library District, represent their communities, and advocate for the library district at the local and state level. Five of the seven Trustees are appointed from Snohomish County.

Snohomish County resident Rico Tessandore will complete his second term on December 31, 2021.
