### **Consideration:**

Proposed Motion 22-151 would approve and authorization of the County Executive to sign Supplement No. 1 to Professional Services Agreement (CCF04-21) with David Evans and Associates, Inc. to provide additional environmental documentation and drainage design services for the 36<sup>th</sup>/35<sup>th</sup> Avenue West Improvement project, under SCC 3.04.190<sup>1</sup>.

### **Background:**

In February 2009, Snohomish County and the City of Lynnwood entered into an agreement to improve a segment of 36<sup>th</sup>/35<sup>th</sup> Avenue West between 164<sup>th</sup> Street SW to SR 99, with the City of Lynnwood as the lead entity (Motion 09-037). The City of Lynnwood has completed their portion of the project.

In July of 2021 the County Executive's Office approved the issuance of a Notice of Intent to Sole Source (SS-005-21BT) a contract with David Evans and Associates to ensure continuity of the project.

In September of 2021, Snohomish County approved Professional Services Agreement CCF04-21 (Motion 21-340)<sup>2</sup> with an agreement amount of \$317,092.62 for design services to complete the final plans for the County's portion of the 36<sup>th</sup>/35<sup>th</sup> Ave West (164<sup>th</sup> Street SW to SR 99), approved Transportation Improvement Project E.40.01.

### **Current Proposal:**

*Scope:* Approval by motion is sought from Council to authorize the County Executive to sign Supplement No. 1 to Professional Services Agreement CCF04-21 between Snohomish County and David Evans and Associates, Inc. The proposed supplement was negotiated for \$59,613.65, to include the additional environmental documentation and drainage design necessary for the project.

*Duration:* Execution through December 31, 2024. (No change)

*Fiscal Implications:* The total for this agreement is \$376,706.27, which includes the original amount of \$317,092.62 and the proposed supplement cost of \$59,613.65. The previously authorized appropriations authority of the Public Works Director to approve amendments up to \$31,709.00 remains available and valid.
