PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 26-022

RELATING TO THE 2025-2026 BUDGET; MAKING AN EMERGENCY
APPROPRIATION IN FUND 100 TO INCREASE EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR
THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO COVER UNANTICIPATED LOSS OF REVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. The County Council makes the following findings of fact: An emergency appropriation of \$140,000 is necessary in the Community Impact (Special Revenue) Fund 100, in the Prosecuting Attorney's 2025-2026 budget, to increase expenditure authority to absorb expenses creating a negative cash balance in Fund 118, Crime Victim Witness Fund caused by an unanticipated reduction in revenue.

Section 2. The appropriation details for the emergency appropriation are as follows:

100 Community Impact (Special Revenue) Fund

EXPENDITURE:

100.507315191011 Regular Salaries \$98,000.00

100.507315192013 Personnel Benefits \$42,000.00

Total Supplemental Appropriation \$140,000.00

REVENUE:

100.307315190800 \$140,000.00

Total Revenue \$140,000.00

Section 3. The County Council further finds that there is a need for this emergency appropriation to alleviate a negative cash balance in Fund 118, which was created by an unanticipated level of reduction in revenue provided by the State for State mandated services provided under Fund 118. The level to which funding would be reduced was not known at the time Council adopted the 2025-2026 budget. The County Council therefore finds that the need for the appropriation authorized by this ordinance constitutes a public emergency that could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of budget adoption for 2025-2026 and hereby authorizes the appropriation.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
