## **Consideration:**

Approve the acceptance of a Real Property Donation by Anton Stetner, adjacent to Whitehorse Trail.

## **Background:**

In accordance with 36.70A.130 RCW, Snohomish County's Growth Management Act, Comprehensive Plan was updated in June of 2015 through approval of Motion 14-129. The Comprehensive Plan includes a <u>Parks Element</u> as required by 36.70A.070 RCW.

The Parks Element adopted in 2015 includes a goal to provide open spaces and preserve natural areas. Donation of this property helps support this goal of providing open spaces within the County.

## **Current Proposal:**

Donor: Anton Stetner

Scope: The Donor would give the County 5.72 acers of undeveloped land adjacent

to Whitehorse Trail. DCNR has indicated that they will retain the property in

a natural forested canopy along the trail corridor.

Cost: 1. \$120,000 – The land was appraised on July 28, 2021 and appraised at

this value.
