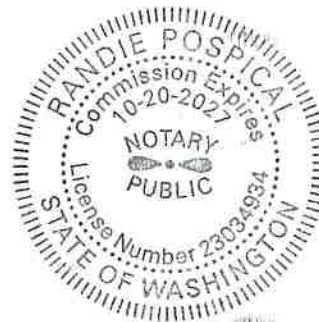

**PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 25-037
RELATING TO THE 2025-2026 BUDGET, MAKING AN
EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION IN SHERIFF SEARCH AND
RESCUE HELICOPTER FUND 141 TO PROVIDE
ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR
UNANTICIPATED COSTS**

Summary: The ordinance approves an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$125,000 to provide expenditure authority to pay for unanticipated costs related to replacement of a helicopter hoist. In 2024, the Sheriff's Office obtained a quote from Goodrich Hoist to replace the helicopter hoist for \$225,000, excluding tax. Based on the quote, the Sheriff's Office requested and received \$225,000 in grant funding through UASI. In 2025, Goodrich Hoist was acquired by Onboard Systems Hoist & Winch, which has issued a new quote for \$329,044, excluding sales tax. Additional appropriation is needed to complete the purchase of the helicopter hoist replacement.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.

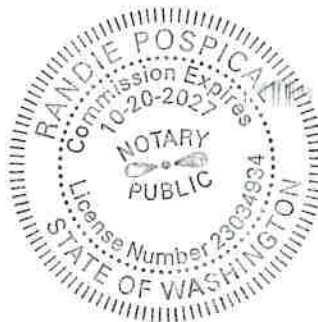
