RELATING TO COUNTY BUDGETS AND BUDGET PROCEDURES, PROVIDING
FOR ANNUAL BUDGETS, REMOVING AUTHORITY TO ADOPT A BIENNIAL
BUDGET FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2023, AND
REPEALING SCC 4.26.017

WHEREAS, by Amended Ordinance No. 20-009 the County Council authorized the County to implement biennial budgeting beginning with the 2023-2024 biennium as provided by the County Charter, state law, and county code; and

WHEREAS, the County Council finds that given the Covid-19 pandemic which started in 2020, and the subsequent continuing impacts to the needs of the citizens and the fluctuating economic and resource needs, it would be in the best interests of the County to adopt annual budgets for the period beginning January 1, 2023, and thereafter as provided herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 4.26.017, adopted by Amended Ordinance No. 20-009, on February 26, 2020, is repealed.

At the hearing, Council may consider alternatives/amendments to the proposed ordinance.

The chair of the council may choose to limit testimony to three minutes in the interest of accommodating all persons wishing to testify. 

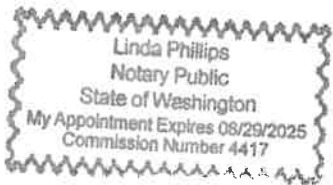
