**Subject:** Washington State Broadband Office – Infrastructure Acceleration Grant

between Snohomish County and Washington State Department of

Commerce; contract number 22-96810-011

**Scope:** The proposed grant agreement is with the Washington State Department

of Commerce for American Rescue Recovery Plan Act State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) for Snohomish County and Ziply, to expand broadband services into rural areas of Snohomish County, specifically the

State Route (SR) 530 Broadband Project.

This is a proposed multi-year project with funding expiration set for 2025. The agreement would accept funding and proceed with related construction and use agreements for the SR 530 Broadband Project. This

agreement is related to ECAF 2023-0825/Motion 23-490.

<u>Duration:</u> Start Date: July 1, 2021; End Date June 30, 2025, contingent on

reappropriation, which has been verified.

<u>Authority Granted:</u> Approving and authorizing the Executive to execute the Infrastructure Acceleration Grant Agreement between Snohomish County and the

Washington State Department of Commerce Broadband Office.

<u>Background:</u> Snohomish County submitted a joint application to the Washington State Department of Commerce, Broadband Office (WSBO) with Ziply Fiber NW, LLC to construct a Fiber to the Premise (FttP) network along or near the SR 530 Corridor from the City of Arlington to the City of Darrington.

Snohomish County has received an Infrastructure Acceleration grant award from WSBO for American Rescue Recovery Plan Act state and local fiscal recovery funds (SLFRF) for the SR 530 Broadband Project, that spans multiple years and will enable gigabit fiber connectivity to approximately 4,510 addresses.
