Subject: Amendment 1 to the Interlocal Agreement between Snohomish County and the Alderwood Water and Wastewater District (AWWD).

Scope: Proposed Amendment 1 would amend the existing Interlocal Agreement ([Motion 21-470](#)) to accurately reflect the final scope of work and costs associated with the utility work as stipulated in the accepted bid.

Authority Granted: Approves and authorizes the County Executive to sign Amendment 1 to the Interlocal Agreement between Snohomish County and the Alderwood Water and Wastewater District concerning Utility Construction Associated with the 36th/35th Ave West: 164th Street SW-SR 99 Road Project, under RCW 39.34.030 and SCC 13.01.020(5).

Background: Snohomish County has a public road improvement project (TIP #E.40.01) to improve the 36th/35th Ave West corridor from 164th St SW to SR 99. In January 2022 Snohomish County entered into an Interlocal Agreement with the Alderwood Water and Wastewater District which would allow the County to perform Utility Work (relocate water lines, etc.) on behalf of the district. Upon review of the accepted bid, an amendment was negotiated to include the accurate accepted bid amounts and work descriptions.

Requested Action: Move to GLS on May 29th, 2024, for consideration.
