Consideration

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 21-311, which would approve and authorize an interlocal agreement between Snohomish County and Everett Public Schools.

Background

The County, through the Sheriff's office, provides contract law enforcement services to agencies throughout Snohomish County, this includes providing School Resource Officers to school districts. The Sheriff's office currently provides School Resources Officers (SRO's) to Everett School District, Sultan School District, Mukilteo School District and Snohomish School District. RCW's [28A.320.124](#), [28A.320.1241](#), [28A.320.1242](#) and [28A.320.125](#) all provide information related to the nature of the agreements and services performed.

Everett Public Schools wishes to renew their ILA for SRO services at Gateway Middle School. These services have been in place since 2018 and the most recent agreement was last approved on April 17, 2019 by Motion 19-092¹ and amended on February 10, 2021 by Motion 21-038.²

Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 21-311 approves an agreement to provide SRO services at Gateway Middle School and authorizes the executive to execute all related agreements.

Duration: Initial term: upon execution to August 31, 2022. Term may be renewed for up to two (2) additional (1) year terms. Termination is allowed for any reason with thirty (30) days written notice.

Fiscal Implications: \$122,947 for the initial term (this represents 75% of the total costs given that the deputy is reassigned when school is not in session.)

2021 Budget: YES. \$122,947

Future Budget Impacts: \$126,636 for 2022-2023 and \$130,435 for 2023-2024.

Handling: URGENT. (School is in session)

Approved-as-to-form: YES.

Risk Management: APPROVE.

Executive Recommendation: APPROVE.

Analysis: The ILA is in compliance with RCW.
