Background: The Snohomish County Information Technology Department has negotiated with the Snohomish County School District 201 for use of the County's technology infrastructure and expertise since 2020. The proposed agreement includes an approved rate model for established contract pricing for any agreed upon information technology services via Work Orders, along with an agreement to share space within the County's data center for cross connections to State, County and other agencies. Additionally, the Snohomish County School District 201 is providing the County with a connection to the Snohomish Police Department.
