## **Consideration:**

Appointing Commissioner to represent the District 1 position for the Citizens' Commission on Salaries of Elected Officials.

## **Background**

Snohomish County Ordinance 07-053, passed in June of 2007, established the Snohomish County Citizen's Commission on Salaries of Elected Officials. Local code charges the Auditor with randomly selecting six Snohomish County citizens – one from each Council District and one at-large – from the county voter registration rolls to serve on the Commission on Salaries. The County Executive is responsible for nominating four individuals – one from each of the following sectors; business, personnel management, legal profession, and organized labor.

Pursuant to SCC 2.105.040(3), the County Executive recommends the re-appointment of Carol Panagos, selected by lot to represent District 1. Commission members are limited to two consecutive terms.
