Authority Granted: Snohomish County Council hereby finds it is in the public interest to surplus/donate/transfer the Freightliner MT 55 Stepvan to North County Fire/EMS and authorizes the Property Officer of the Department of Facilities and Fleet, Property Management Division to sign any and all documents necessary to effectuate the transfer of the Property to the North County Fire/EMS, under SCC 4.46.201 and 4.47.171.

Background: In 2006 the Snohomish County Department of Emergency Management procured a Freightliner MT 55 Stepvan to be used in the response to natural disasters. The vehicle has been lent to local fire departments and other emergency response agencies and jurisdictions for use as a command center. The County DEM has not utilized the vehicle as much as originally anticipated and wishes to donate the vehicle to the North County Fire/EMS. The North County Fire/EMS has utilized the vehicle most frequently since the county acquisition. By donating the vehicle to the North County Fire/EMS, they will then become responsible for the expense of maintenance and repairs.

Requested Action: For Council to move the motion to GLS on May 14, 2025, for consideration.
