INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this staff report is to provide the County Council with a proposed motion for consideration. The motion would authorize the County Executive to sign the attached interlocal agreement (ILA) between the City of Gold Bar and Snohomish County regarding the provision of fire inspection services. This includes building, construction, and fire plan review, and on-site code inspections such as new construction inspections and annual inspections for fire and life/safety. The City of Gold Bar has a population of around 2,403 residents.

BACKGROUND

An updated ILA for the provision of fire inspection services including a new fee schedule has been agreed to by the parties.

The attached ILA titled, "Interlocal Agreement Between the City of Gold Bar and Snohomish County Concerning Provision of Building, Construction, Fire Plan Review, and Code Inspection Services," would:

- Allow the Office of the County Fire Marshall (OCFM) to provide fire inspection services on a
 case-by-case basis when requested by the City of Gold Bar. The County would perform
 inspection functions pursuant to the terms and conditions in the agreement; and
- The parties have negotiated and agreed to the terms of the agreement.
 - o The City of Gold Bar approved the agreement on November 20, 2022.

If the motion is approved, the Executive is authorized to complete the following:

 Execute the "Interlocal Agreement Between the City of Gold Bar and Snohomish County Concerning Provision of Building, Construction, Fire Plan Review, and Code Inspection Services."

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

PDS recommends that County Council approve the motion to authorize the County Executive to sign the attached ILA with the City of Gold Bar regarding the provision of fire inspection services.
