APPROVING THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN A REGIONAL APPRENTICESHIP PATHWAYS PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE TO SIGN AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE OFFICE OF THE SUPERINTENDENT FOR PUBLIC INSTRUCTION FOR THE SAME

Background: The ordinance approves Snohomish County's participation in a Regional Apprenticeship Pathways Project and authorize the Executive to sign an interlocal agreement with the Office of the Superintendent for Public Instruction to oversee the use of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds at the Marysville School District. Snohomish County's Office of Recovery and Resilience (ORR) recommends \$150,000 for the Regional Apprenticeship Pathways (RAP) program. The Marysville School District is authorized by the Regulatory Apprenticeship Council to operate the RAP program to provide Snohomish County high school students with education and training in building and construction trades.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
