RESOLUTION NO. 22-030

RECOGNIZING MAY 6-12, 2022, AS NATIONAL NURSES WEEK

WHEREAS, National Nurses Week begins each year on May 6th and ends on May 12th, which is Florence Nightingale's birthday; and

WHEREAS, the 8th of May is designated as National Student Nurses Day, and National School Nurse Day is celebrated on the Wednesday within National Nurses Week each year; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, the American Nurses Association expanded National Nurses Week to a month-long celebration in May with weekly themes including: Self Care, Recognition, Professional Development and Community Engagement; and

WHEREAS, "Rooted in Strength" is the theme for 2022 as announced by American Association of Critical-Care Nurses; and

WHEREAS, Washington has over 68,000 practicing registered nurses; and

WHEREAS, nurses are the heart of healthcare, having a critical responsibility to uphold the highest level of quality and standards in their practice, including fostering a safe work environment; and


WHEREAS, nursing is a physically demanding position, many nurses cycle through 12-hour shifts on their feet, giving up holidays with their families and working through nights and weekends; and

WHEREAS, the depth and breadth of the registered nursing profession meet the different and emerging health care needs of the American population in a wide range of settings; and


WHEREAS, nursing, in general, is stressful and COVID-19 only amplifies that, we recognize the commitment of our nursing professionals and the irreplaceable role they have in our healthcare ecosystem, requiring critical thinking, advanced training, compassion and attentive care;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Snohomish County Council does hereby recognize May 6 – 12, 2022, as National Nurses Week in Snohomish County and encourage Snohomish County residents to recognize and show appreciation to nurses and the contributions nurses make to our community.




