## **BACKGROUND:**

- This project replaces the existing single-lane timber bridge with a modern two-lane structure with shoulders.
- Construction of this project will require ROW acquisition from two (2) parcels and temporary easements from one (1) parcel. The Right-of-Way phase is scheduled to begin in early 2022.
- Estimates for ROW acquisition are based upon the Right of Way Funding estimate provided by Engineering Services.
- The ROW phase of the project is funded with Federal FHWA funds with a 20% local match.
- The project is in Council District #1.
- Collaboration with local tribes has been initiated and is ongoing.
- LDA Noticing was mailed July 8<sup>th</sup>.
- A public survey was conducted of area residents and stakeholders to determine if a full road closure or a detour bridge with intermittent closures is preferred. The majority of responses favored a full road closure.
