REAPPOINTING LEAH EVERETT TO  
THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Planning Commission is established and administered pursuant to chapter 2.08 SCC; and

WHEREAS, appointments to fill vacant planning commission positions are made pursuant to Snohomish County Charter section 2.20 and SCC 2.08.080; and

WHEREAS, Planning Commissioner Leah Everett is nearing the end of her first term representing Council District 5 on the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, SCC 2.08.080 states that vacancies shall be filled by the Council with nominees from the County Council and/or Executive; and

WHEREAS, SCC 2.08.080(2) sets out the procedure by which the County council will hold a public hearing on nominations and make affirmative findings on the following:

1. Is the nominee a full-time resident of Snohomish County?
2. Is the nominee not a Snohomish County employee except while serving as a temporary appointee?
3. Does the nominee have sufficient time to attend all scheduled commission meetings?

WHEREAS, SCC 2.08.080 also states that it is desirable that the nominee has knowledge of a) land use theories, b) growth management and agricultural preservations studies, c) have a minimum potential for conflict of interest, d) have a demonstrated interest in the welfare of Snohomish County, and e) add balance to county-wide representation on the commission; and

WHEREAS, Leah Everett is a full-time resident of District 5, has been capably representing the district on the Planning Commission most recently acting as its Vice-Chair, has relevant knowledge, is not a Snohomish County employee, and has indicated the ability and willingness to continue attending scheduled commission meetings with a second term beginning in July 2022; and

WHEREAS, under Snohomish County Charter section 2.20 and SCC 2.08.080, Councilmember Sam Low representing District 5 has renominated Leah Everett for appointment to a District 5 position for a second full term, to expire four years from the effective date of this motion; and

WHEREAS, the County Council held a public hearing on \_\_\_\_\_, 2022, to consider the renomination;

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the Snohomish County Council finds that the nominee meets the criteria set out in SCC 2.08.080 and hereby appoints Leah Everett to the Snohomish County Planning Commission to serve a second full term, which expires on \_\_\_\_\_, 2026.

**Background**

Leah Everett was appointed to the Planning Commission in July 2018 representing District 5. Ms. Everett has served capably on the commission, including serving as its vice-chair. SCC 2.08.080 provides for renominations of planning commissioners. County Councilmember Sam Low is renominating Leah Everett to a second full term on the commission.

The Planning Commission has eleven positions, ten of which are currently occupied. Reappointment of Leah Everett would help maintain that number.

**Current Proposal**

*Scope:* Motion 22-227 would reappoint Leah Everett to the Planning Commission

*Effective Date:* Commissioner Everett's second term would begin at the conclusion of her first term in July 2022.


