BETWEEN SNOHOMISH REGIONAL FIRE & RESCUE AND
SNOHOMISH COUNTY FOR EVERGREEN STATE FAIR PARK
FIRE PROTECTION AND RELATED SERVICES

Summary: The ordinance approves an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with Snohomish County Fire Protection District was approved to provide emergency fire and first-aid response services to the Evergreen State Fairgrounds for its annual operations. The Fair Park property is located within the boundaries of Snohomish Regional Fire and Rescue. The County Fair Park does not pay property taxes, thus the ILA covers the costs and is the most economical and efficient means in providing fire and emergency services. This Agreement is for three-years ending on December 31, 2026. The cost for 2024 is \$43,150.78 for year-round fire protection and \$44,362.64 for fair services and first aid during the annual Evergreen State Fair, for a total amount of \$87,513.42. The agreement amount will increase as determined by the annual CPI in June of every year for the following year cost. At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
