Consideration

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 22-224 which would approve and authorize an agreement with the City of Everett for the Sex Offender Address and Residency Verification Program.

Background

The Snohomish County Sheriff's Office, Everett Police Department and the Prosecutors Office created a task force which allows for address verification and consistent prosecution of registered sex offenders.

The County receives grant dollars from the Washington Association of Sheriff and Police Chiefs (WASPC), who receives the funds from the State, for operation of this program.

Since 2009, the County has entered into annual ILA's with the City of Everett to fund one detective position to support the program.

Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 22-224 continues the agreement with the City of Everett for an additional year and funds the cost of one (1) Detective for this work.

The motion before you is substantially similar to those in prior years and would approve a one year contract to fund the one detective position at \$101,000.

Duration: July 1, 2021-June 30, 2022.

Fiscal Implications: \$101,000

2022 Budget: YES. Grant funds are distributed by State Fiscal Years. Funding for the duration of this ILA (July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022) was approved in the 2021 Grant Work Plan and included in both the 2021 and 2022 adopted budgets.
