Consideration:

Approve an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Stanwood and Snohomish County for the SR 532 Roundabout and 102nd Avenue Bypass Feasibility Study.

Background:

Annually, the County Council adopts a Capital Improvement Program budget that includes City/Council Partnership Projects. During the 2021 budget process \$750,000 was set aside in Ordinance 20-071 for these projects (projects added via Amendment #1). While funding was appropriated for each of these projects in the budget, ILA's with each jurisdiction are required in order to disburse the funds.

The ILA before you is for:

City: Stanwood
Project: 532 Roundabout and 102nd Avenue Bypass Feasibility Study
Amount: \$25,000
Fund Source: REET 2
Scope: Conduct a feasibility study to consider potential bypass routes for SR532. The project will include 1) bypass feasibility; develop roadway layout concepts; and community outreach.

The motion provides the Executive amendment authority for this ILA, as long as the amendments do not increase the amount of the ILA.
