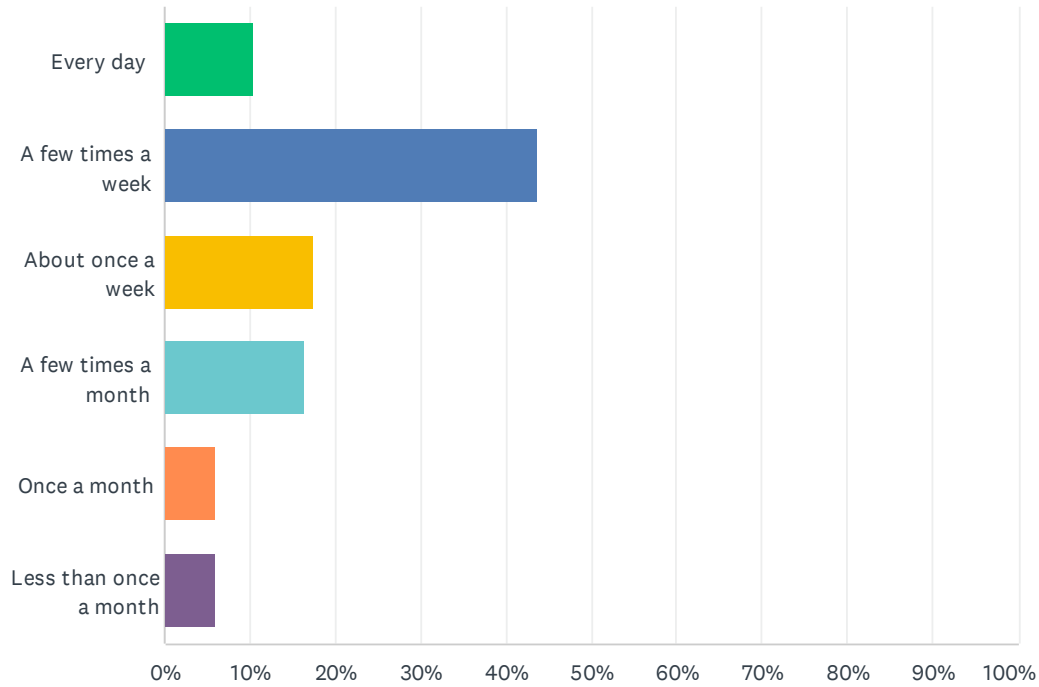


## Q1 How OFTEN do you use parks, recreation, and open space facilities or programs?

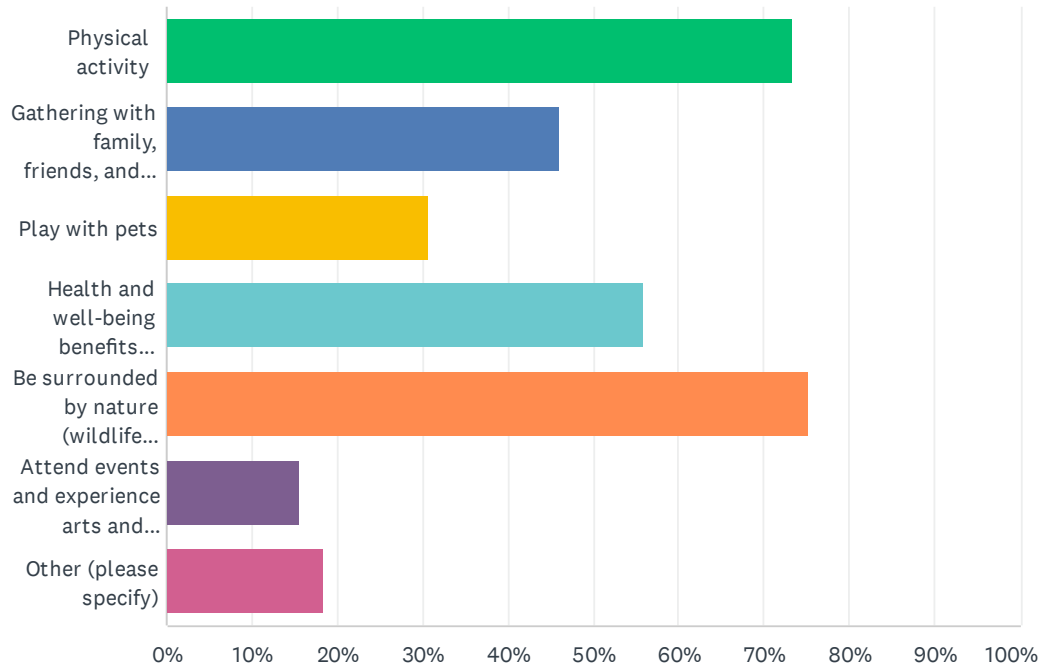

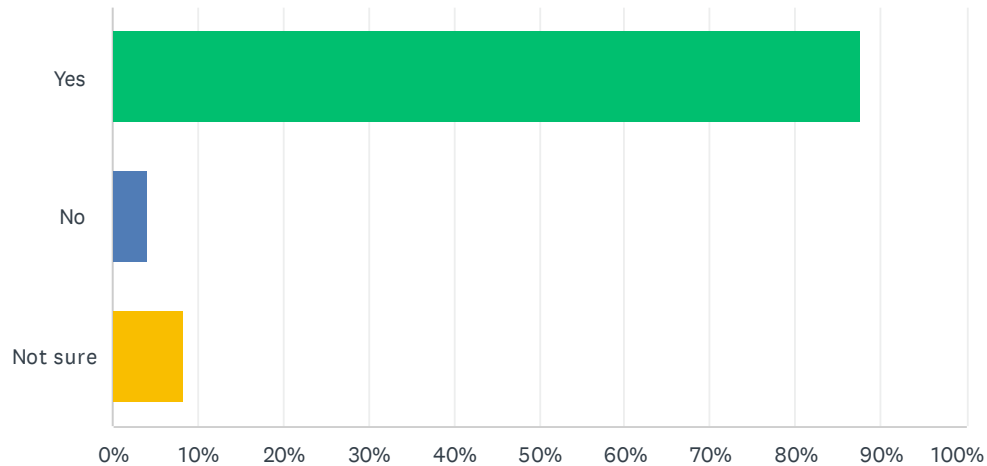

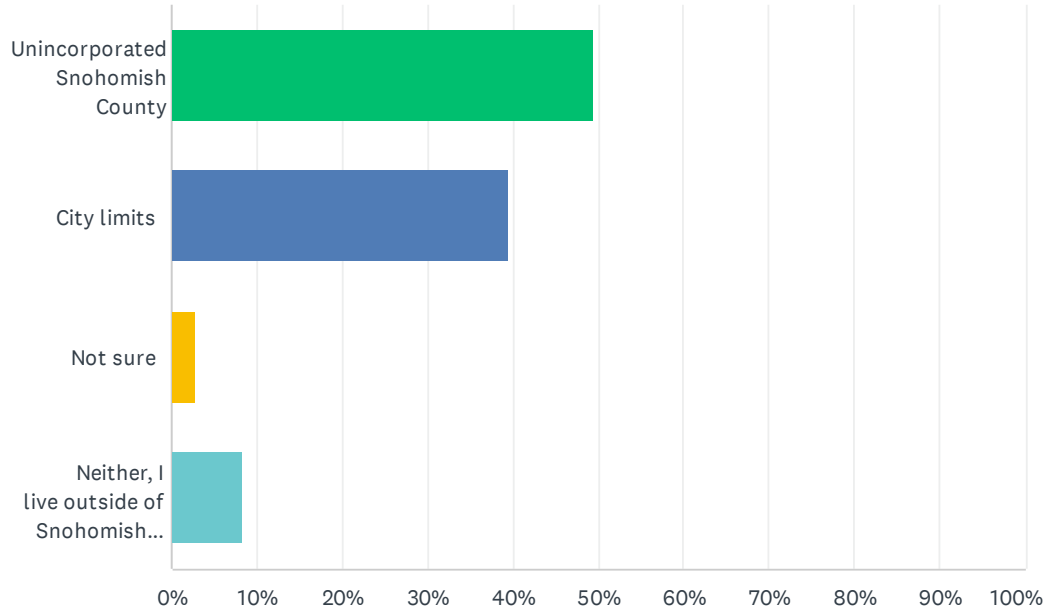

## Q4 Do you live within UNINCORPORATED SNOHOMISH COUNTY or within CITY LIMITS?

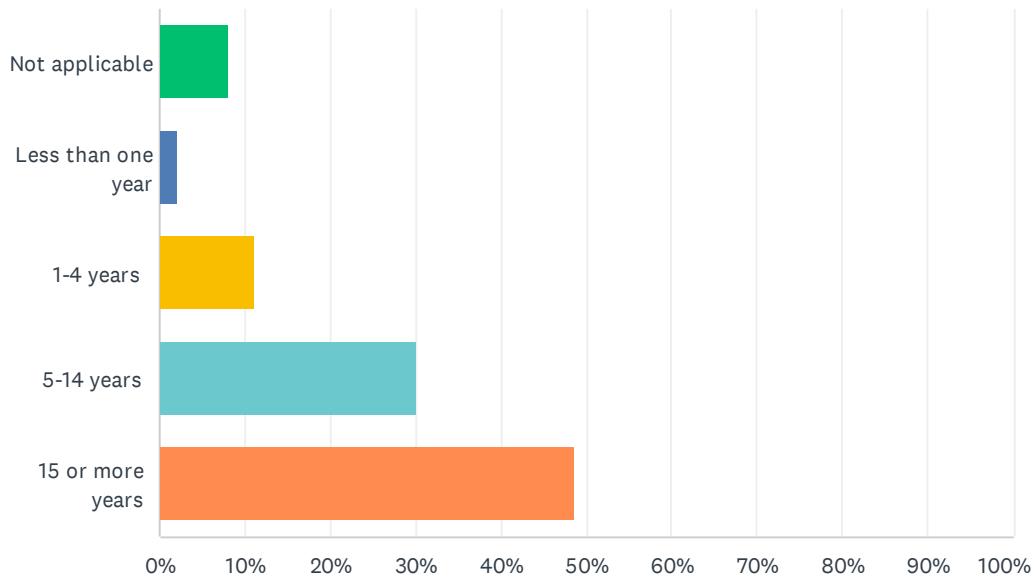

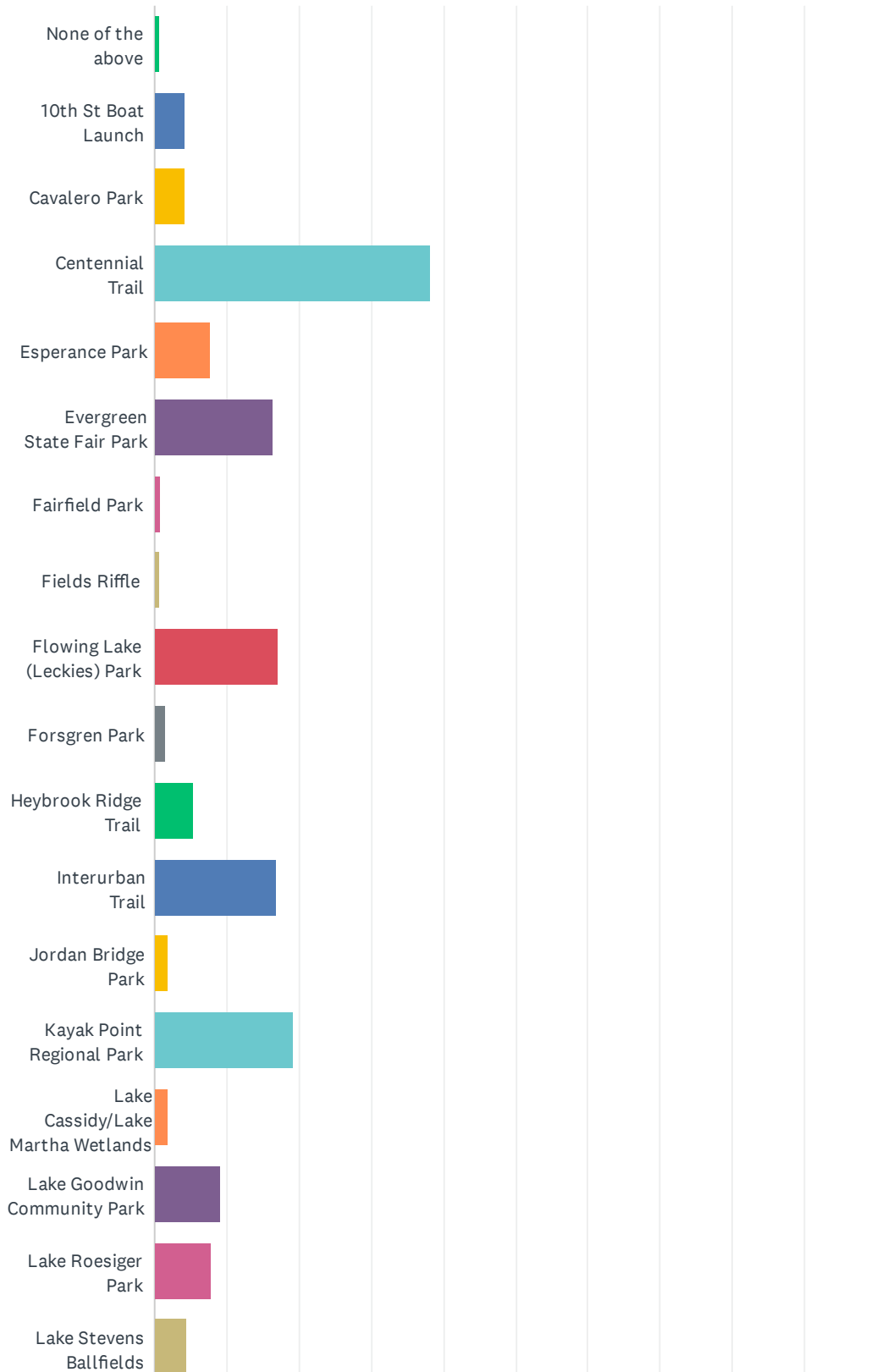

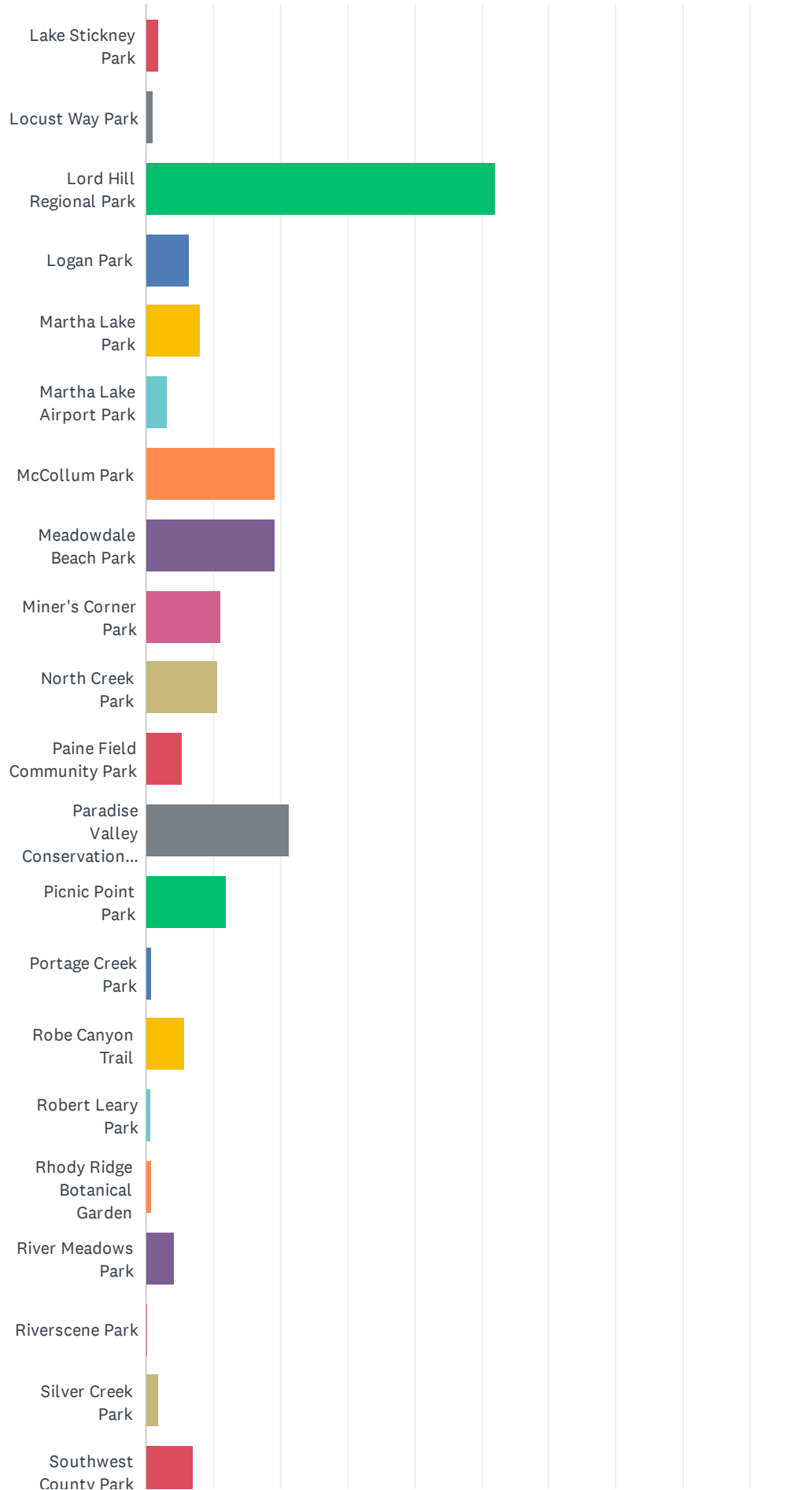


## Q6 Which Snohomish County Parks facilities do you USE MOST OFTEN? (Select up to 5)

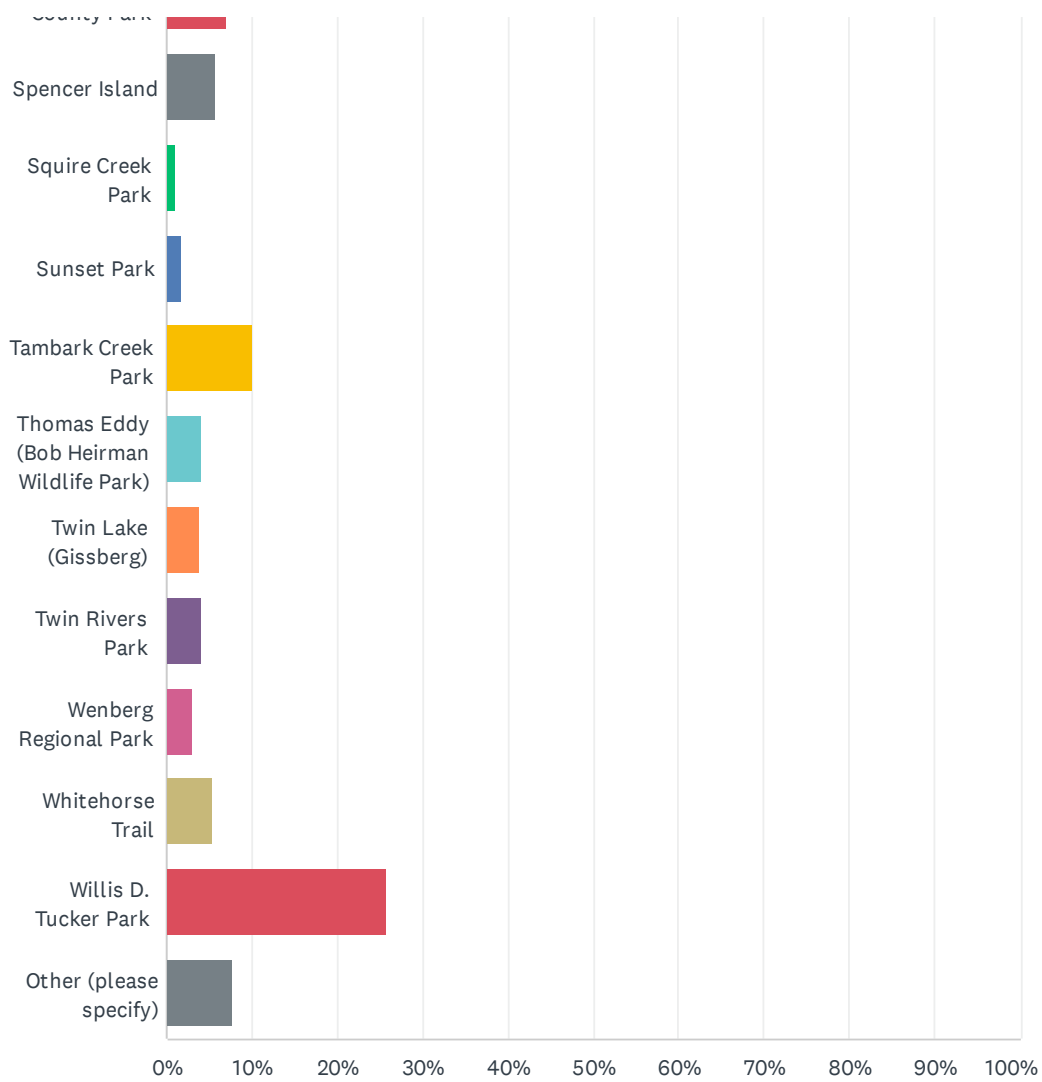

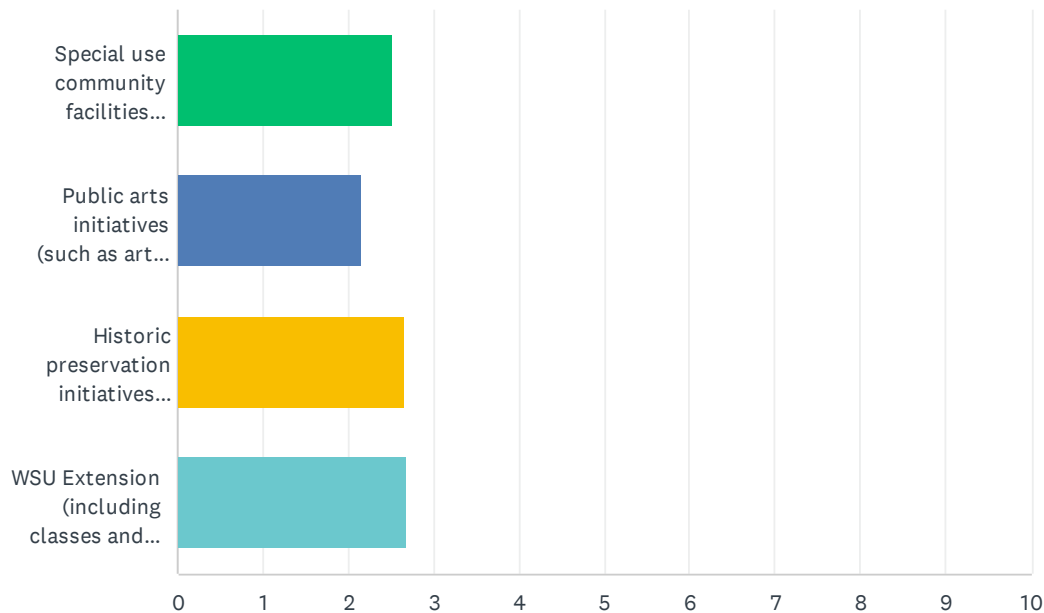

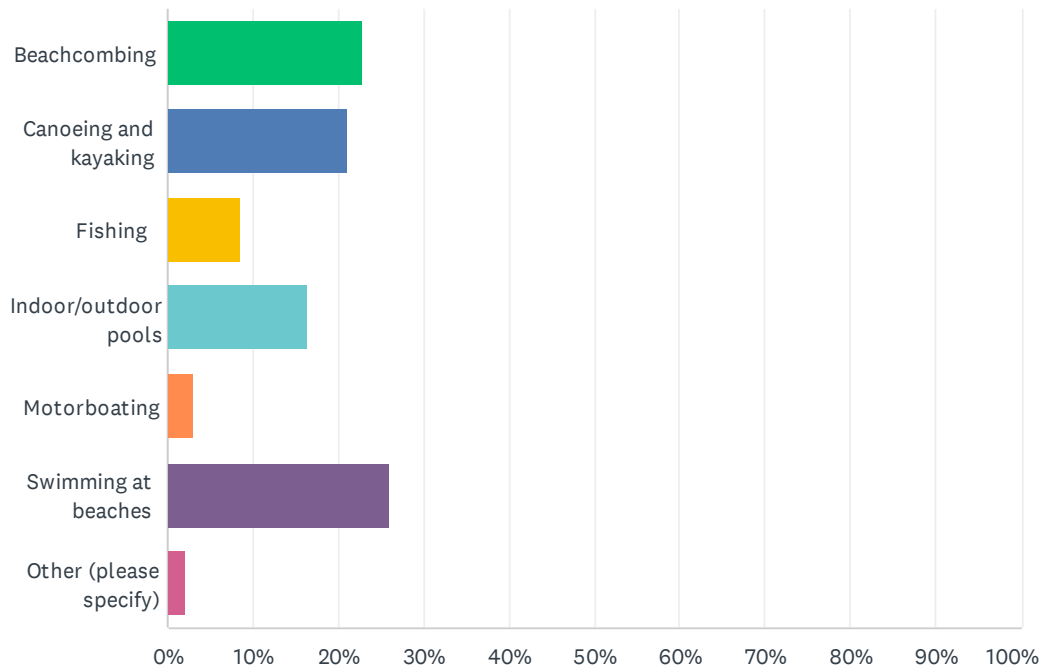

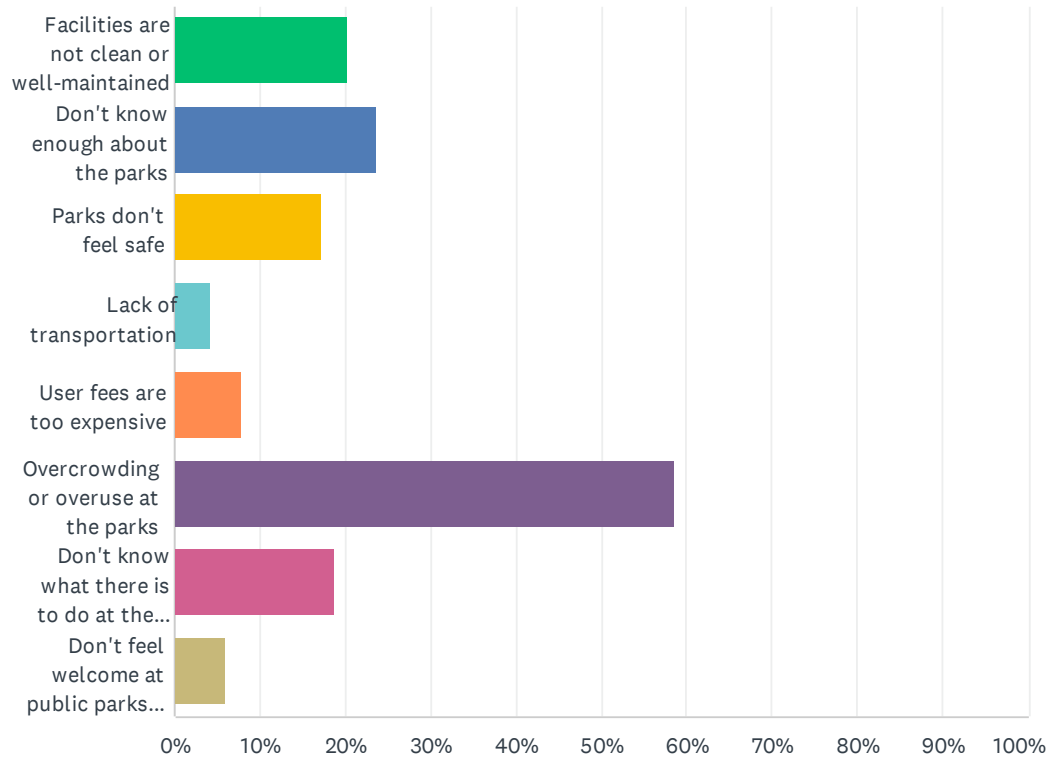

## Q20 What BARRIERS prevent you from enjoying Snohomish County Parks? (Select all that apply)

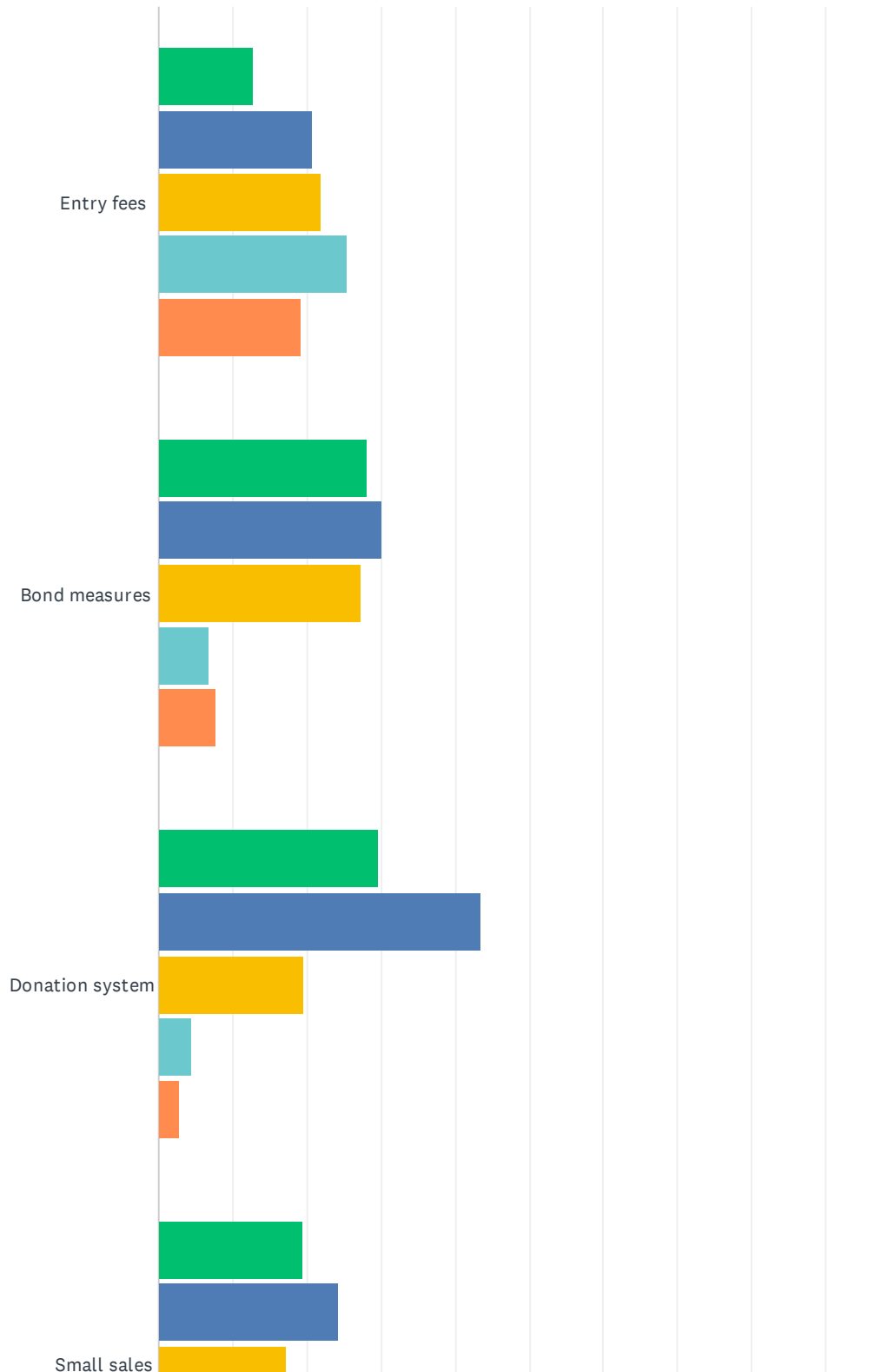

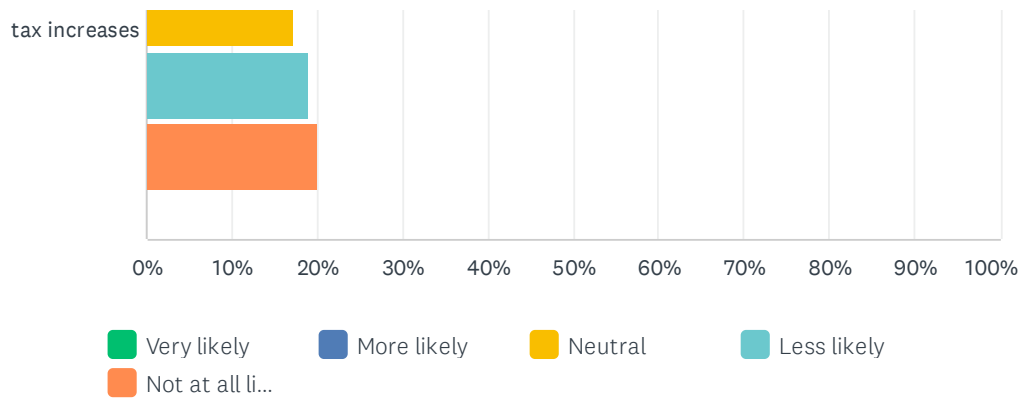

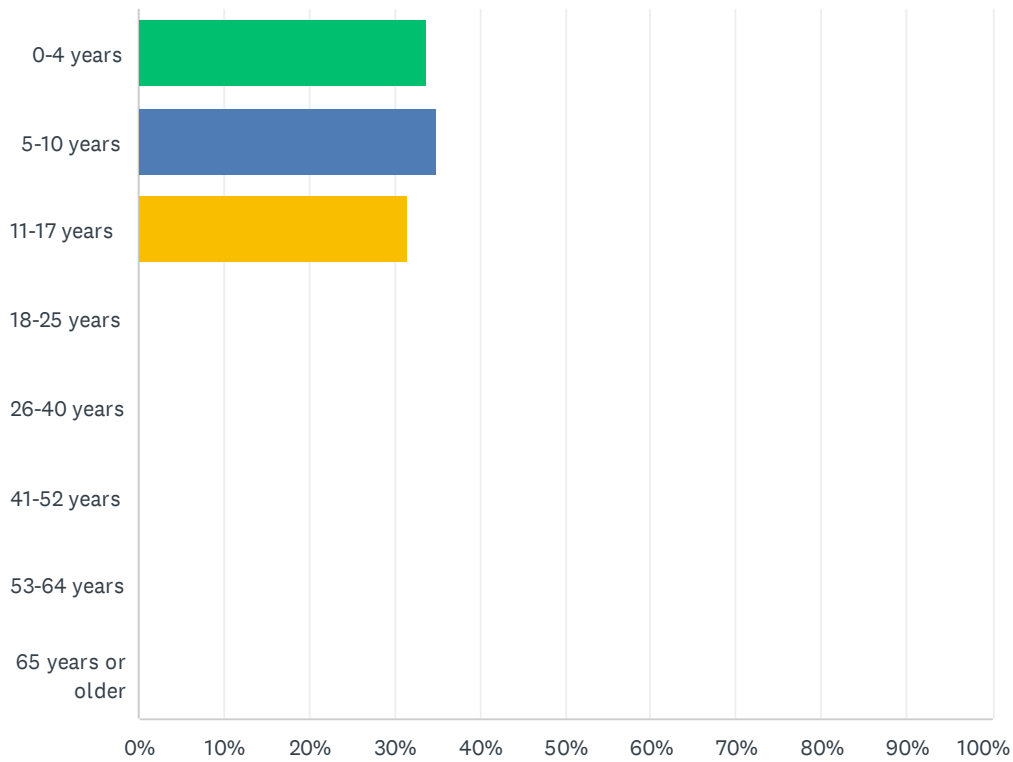

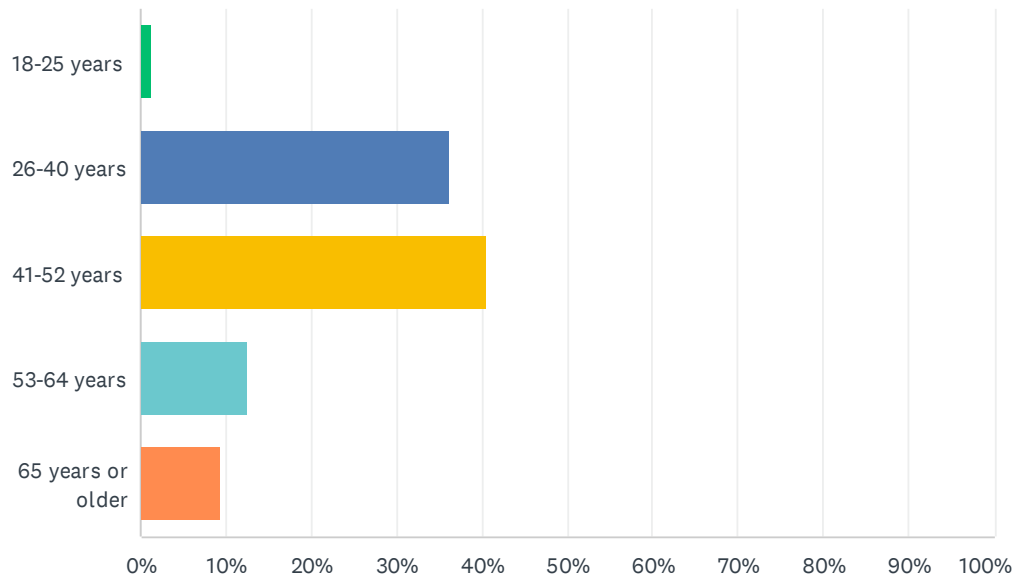
