APPROVING DATA SHARING AGREEMENT WITH WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH Summary. The ordinance approves a data sharing agreement with the Washington State Department of Health (DOH). Snohornish County, acting through its Health Department, needs access to the Washington Emergency Medical Services Information Systems (WEMSIS). The DOH's Opiol and Drug Use Data Dashboard consolidates historically isolated data products into a single data dashboard and provides aggregated overdose and use data at the county, region, and state level. Access to the dashboard provides the Health Department the ability to monitor the impacts of substance, opiold, and stimulant use in our communities and our overdoses transported to a medical facility and response time.
