Approving awards of Small Capital Project Partnership (SCPP) grants for 2021.

Background

The Small Capital Projects Partnership (SCPP) is a council initiative authorized in 2012. The purpose is to provide supporting funds for small capital projects in Snohomish County to applicants who have partnered with a public entity on whose land the field or facility is located. The resource for this initiative is Real Estate Excise Tax II. The budget in 2021 is \$10,000 per Council District.

Current Proposal

This motion approves the 2021 SCPP grant awards for Council District 3.

- Total awards = \$10,000
- Application deadline was June 1, 2021, extended to September 30th; applications evaluated by staff, and funding recommendations presented to Council.
- Six applications were received.
- One application is recommended for funding at this time, with the City of Lynnwood for playground replacement at the Lynndale Skate Park.

Approval by Motion is sought from Council to approve the recommendations for the Small Capital Project Partnerships and direct staff to prepare agreements with the successful applicants.
