RE: Re-Appointment to the Snohomish County Human Rights Commission

I am pleased to recommend the re-appointment of Noah Rui to the Snohomish County Human Rights Commission (SCHRC).

The Snohomish County Human Rights Commission serves as an advisory body to the County Executive, County Council, Office of Human Rights and other county officers and agencies in matters concerning Human Rights. The commission consists of nine members appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council. Members of the commission shall serve without compensation.

Noah Rui resides in Snohomish County. Noah has been involved in the community in numerous ways, most notably: six years in the Mayor's Diversity Advisory Committee for Jon Nehring of Marysville. Noah began and fostered a sister city relationship bringing Chinese delegations from China to Marysville and one from delegation of Marysville to China. Noah has also volunteered in schools bimonthly for the last seven years.

This nomination has been discussed with Snohomish County Council Representative of District 1, Nate Nehring.

Pursuant to SCC 2.03.030, I hereby urge the Council's confirmation of Noah Rui to be re-appointed to the Snohomish County Human Rights Commission to a term ending on June 30, 2024.
