### BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

The contemplated work to be performed under this contract includes, but is not limited to, the replacement of the existing video system, and related work to including upgrades to the video management system (VMS), video camera replacement, removal of coaxial cables used at existing camera locations, removal of analog video controls, removal of digital video encoders, installation of new fiber optic network, upgrading of the existing intercom system, and interfacing the new equipment with the existing locking control PLC system. All work is to be performed in the active Snohomish County Corrections facility located in Everett, Washington.
