Consideration:

Confirm the appointment of Robert Margulis to the Marine Resources Advisory Committee for an initial three-year term.

Background:

The Marine Resources Advisory Committee (MRC) authorized under Chapter 2.800 SCC was created to address local marine issues and recommend remedial actions to the County Council, the Executive, and to other local governmental entities and tribes upon request from Council or the Executive. MRC is comprised of no more than 13 members with balanced representation from local governments, tribes, affected economic interests and recreational, conservation, or environmental interests.

There are currently 10 members on MRC and three vacancies. One member representing Tulalip tribe, and nine members represent economic or recreational, conservation, or environmental interests. Of those, Council District 2 has three members, Council District's 1 and 3 have two members and Council District's 4, and 5 have one.
