APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE
TO SIGN AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH COMMUNITY
TRANSIT CONCERNING THE ADMINISTRATION OF COMMUTE
TRIP REDUCTION (CTR) PLANS AND PROGRAMS.

Summary: The ordinance approves and authorizes the County
Executive to execute an interlocal Agreement (ILA) with
Community Transit concerning the administration of Commute Trip
Reduction (CTR) Plans and Programs through June 30, 2027,
Pursuant to RCW 70.94.527, the County is required to develop and
adopt a CTR plan for major employers affected in unincorporated
growth areas to reduce commuter vehicle miles traveled and
reduce single-occupant vehicle trips to decrease traffic congestion,
mitigate air pollution levels, that consumption, noise, and energy
use. Snohomish County and Community Transit wish to continue
to implement and administer the CTR plans and programs, aligning
with the Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Technical
Committee's recommendations.
At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to
the proposed ordinance.
