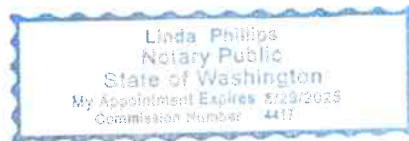

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 22-034
RELATED TO THE 2022 BUDGET; MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN GENERAL FUND 002 FROM FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS TO PROVIDE EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR DISTRICT COURT'S MENTAL HEALTH COURT

WHEREAS, the Washington State Administrative Office of the Courts is providing grant funding to District Court to support District Court's Mental Health Court. Specifically, the funding will allow the Mental Health Program Coordinator to be increased from .5 to 1.0 FTE, will allow the Legal Process Assistant II to be increased from .5 to 1.0 FTE, will provide funding to hire a 1.0 FTE Therapeutic Court Case Manager, and will provide additional funding for equipment, supplies, and transportation.

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. The Snohomish County Council finds as a fact that there are unexpected funds from the Administrative Office of the Courts and that a supplemental appropriation in General Fund 002, for the 2022 budget year, in the amount of \$71,248.13, is necessary to provide expenditure authority to fund staffing and other services for District Court's Mental Health Court.


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
