Approval of Amendment 1 to the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds agreement with Snohomish Health District.

Background

In July of 2021, Snohomish County entered into Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds agreement with Snohomish Health District to provide up to \$150,000 of CLFR funding to the Health District for premium pay for its qualified employees. While that agreement expired on December 31, 2021, Section 31 of the agreement provides for additional time for the parties to complete all close-out requirements.

At this time, the Health District has not completed all applicable administrative actions and all required work of the agreement, and the County and the Health District desire to extend the agreement to allow additional time for the District to complete all applicable administrative actions and all required work of the agreement.
