Subject: Contract for Postmortem Toxicology Services with National Medical

Services, Inc.

**Scope:** The office of the Medical Examiner is seeking to enter into an agreement

with National Medical Services for toxicology laboratory services. National Medical Services provides rapid and accurate toxicology testing

for decedents.

The Department notes in ECAF 2024-1726 that rapid toxicology services are needed to maintain accreditation with the National Association of

Medical Examiners, which is required by RCW 36.24.210<sup>1</sup> as of July 1, 2025.

This contract will be paid for using CDMH funds. When these funds are exhausted, General Fund dollars will be used to cover additional expenditures. The contract not to exceed amount is \$584,000 and the

term expires on June 30, 2027.

**<u>Duration:</u>** Execution until June 30, 2027, and may be extended for 2 additional 2-

year terms.

<u>Authority Granted:</u> Motion 24-389 authorizes the County Executive to sign a contract with National Medical Services, Inc., for toxicology services not to exceed the amount of \$584,000 before June 30, 2027.

<u>Background:</u> Toxicology services are part of the Expedited Drug Analysis Program which provides data used in the Medical Examiner's drug overdose dashboard<sup>2</sup> and the Multi-Agency Coordination Group.
