engaging with County government. The Snohomish County IT department manages the global web presence, and the content management has been delegated to publishers throughout the County, over 29 separate departments/offices and many lines of business. The County currently has approximately 7,000 active webpages, 100,000 documents/ images, and 100 webforms across multiple websites, all currently hosted on CivicPlus. The combined traffic to all sites is approximately 1.5 million users/month.

The primary focus of the consultant will be the main County website, but all websites are being included in the scope for awareness, evaluation, and understanding impacts to navigation or other design elements. The County sites have grown over time without a well-defined information architecture. In addition, the County has not consistently followed publishing guidelines for creating and maintaining content.
