## **BRIEF DESCRIPTION:**

The Department of Conservation & Natural Resources (DCNR) requests the use of a "piggyback" or "cooperative purchase" under SCC 3.04.220 utilizing a competitive bid issued and awarded by the Office of Washington State Department of Enterprise Services (DES). A Contract Usage Agreement between Snohomish County and DES authorizing cooperative purchases was approved by the County Council under Motion 24-232 and is currently in effect.

DES issued a Request for Proposals 16122 for Vessel Removal, Disposal, or Salvage Services for Derelict Vessels on 1/19/2023. The RFP contained 5 categories for vessel removal of various sizes and risk factors. The RFP was awarded to all nine contractors who submitted proposals. All contracts expire 3/31/2026, with an ultimate ending date of 3/31/2029. DCNR intends to get quotes from all nine contractors for each project, utilizing the Work Request form provided by DES. DCNR has successfully removed 29 vessels in 7 years utilizing the State program. Issuing a county bid is not expected to result in a more cost effective way of clearing County waterways.
