**Subject:** Sex Offender Address Verification Program – ILA with Everett

**Scope:** Motion 25-428 would approve a one year Interlocal Agreement with the

City of Everett whereby the County will provide the City with \$101,000 to fund one (1) Detective for work supporting the Sex Offender Address Verification Program. This ILA is substantially similar to those in prior

years.

**<u>Authority Granted:</u>** Authorizes the Executive to execute the agreement.

<u>Background:</u> The Snohomish County Sheriff's Office, Everett Police Department and the Prosecutors Office created a task force which allows for address verification and consistent prosecution of registered sex offenders. The County receives grant dollars from the Washington Association of Sheriff and Police Chiefs (WASPC), who receives the funds from the State, for operation of this program. Since 2009, the County has entered into annual ILA's with the City of Everett to fund one detective position to support the program.

**<u>Requested Action:</u>** Move to GLS November 5<sup>th</sup> for consideration.
